

# CENTRAL HIGH DISCIPLINE POLICY

## INFRACTIONS:

### Level I

1. Disruption of Class or Assembly
2. Hallway Misconduct
3. Lunchroom Misconduct
4. Restroom Misconduct
5. Playground Misconduct
6. Bus Misconduct
7. Obscene Language or Gestures
8. Untruthfulness
9. Daily Assignments (incomplete or unreturned)
10. Violation of Dress Code

### Level II

1. Theft
2. Cheating
3. Fighting
4. Destruction of Property
5. Offenses of Weapons
6. Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco  
(Possession and/or use of)
7. Bullying and/or Harassment

## PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE

1<sup>ST</sup> Trip - Warning unless Level II infraction with probationary period.

2<sup>nd</sup> Trip - Call parent or send referral home for a conference.

3<sup>rd</sup> Trip - One (1) day ISS.

4<sup>th</sup> Trip - Three (3) days ISS.

5<sup>th</sup> Trip - Corporal Punishment (max. 2 swats)

6<sup>th</sup> Trip - Corporal Punishment (max. 3 swats)

7<sup>th</sup> Trip - Short term suspension (3 days max.)

8<sup>th</sup> Trip - Administrative Placement

9<sup>th</sup> Trip - Long term suspension or expulsion.

Other disciplinary action may be administered by the Principal at anytime as deemed necessary.

Saturday school may be assigned at anytime by building principal

\*Any student who refuses corporal punishment for any reason, automatically will receive short term suspension. If facilities and staff are available for use, in-school suspension could be used as a means of disciplinary action.

## EXCEPTION (Level II Infractions):

\*Any offense relating to the possession, transmission, and/or use of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol will relate to immediate suspension from school without having to adhere to the steps listed above.

\* Any offense relating to vandalism, damaging or stealing school property or private property could relate to immediate suspension from school without having to adhere to steps listed above.

\* Any student found in possession of, threat, or use of dangerous weapons as defined by state statutes, will be suspended from school for not less that one (1) year as defined by state law.

\*Any student or students caught cheating on a daily assignment or test will receive a zero (0) for that grade and their parents will be notified.
